What is An Evening of Hope?

An Evening of Hope is a fundraiser benefitting the American Cancer Society. This event was created to provide a venue to educate individuals and raise funds for programs and services that benefit cancer patients and their caregivers throughout the community. The evening will include dinner, silent auctions, raffles and more to raise much needed funds. Since the event began in 2018, An Evening of Hope has been able to donate over \$100,000 to the American Cancer Society to help provide programs and services for those battling cancer.

The evening will also include the presentation of the Hope Takes Flight Award which celebrates an unsung hero who has provided so much hope for those battling cancer throughout our community.

Where does the money from this event go?

Money raised from An Evening of Hope helps fund programs, such as Road to Recovery*, and services, like www.cancer.org, 1-800-227-2345, Hope Lodge**, and free wigs, give hope to those diagnosed with cancer and provide a level of support for their caregivers.

The money raised at An Evening of Hope also helps to fund cancer research. The American Cancer Society is second only to the Federal Government in the funding of cancer research — funding researchers who do not qualify for federal funding but who show promise in their area of research. Since the start of the organization, the American Cancer Society has funded 50 Nobel Prize winning researchers.

Many individuals in Washington County have been fortunate to take advantage of the Hope Lodge while undergoing treatment in Baltimore.
